

## DUAL ENROLLMENT FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Students who complete community college credits while in high school through dual enrollment programs are considered freshman students when they apply and come to ASU. This means that students will be admitted to ASU following the freshman admission requirements and are considered for all first-year university scholarships.

3. If a student completes dual enrollment courses in high school and finishes with enough credits to complete an associate degree, it does not matter which degree is posted first. The student will still be considered a first-time freshman at ASU.
4. Dual enrollment students who decide to take additional community college classes after their high school graduation date (i.e., in the summer) and before they apply and have been admitted to ASU, will be considered a transfer student, which will result in fewer scholarship opportunities.
5. Dual enrollment students who apply to ASU early (i.e., the July before beginning their high school senior year), are successfully admitted to ASU and receive notice of their financial aid and scholarship packaging, are able to take additional community college credits after the posting of their high school degree. They will still be considered freshman students and it will not interfere with their scholarship package.
